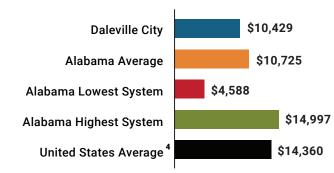

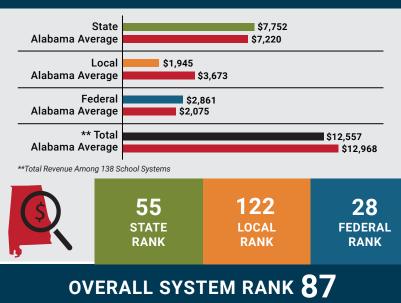

Per-Pupil Revenue Sources

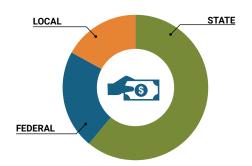
Daleville City Revenue Sources
