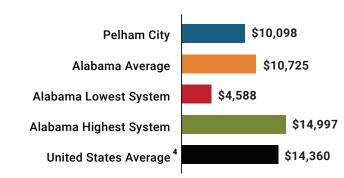

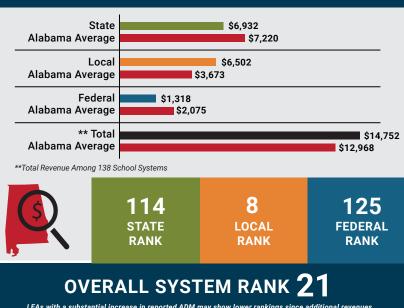

Per-Pupil Revenue Sources

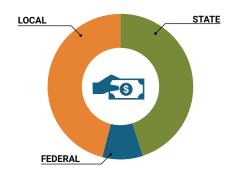
Pelham City Revenue Sources
