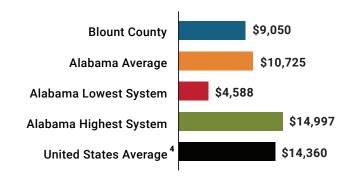

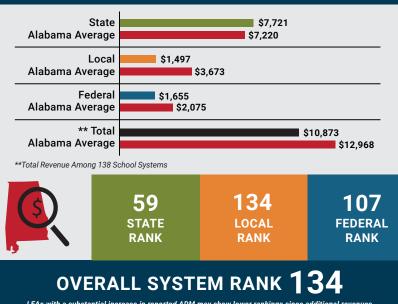

#### **Per-Pupil Revenue Sources**

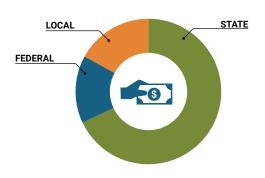
#### Blount County Revenue Sources

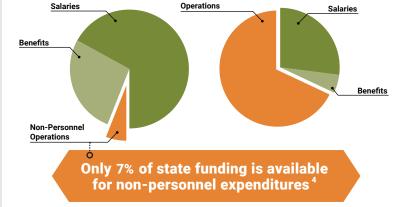
