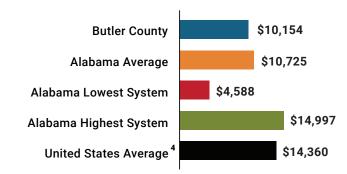

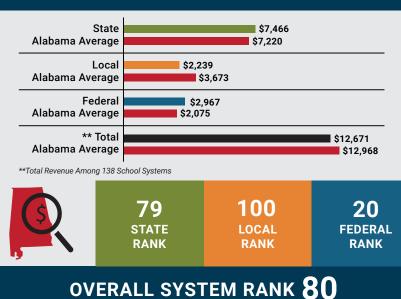

Per-Pupil Revenue Sources

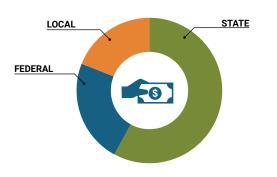
Butler County Revenue Sources
