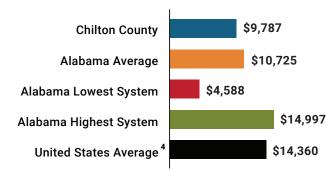

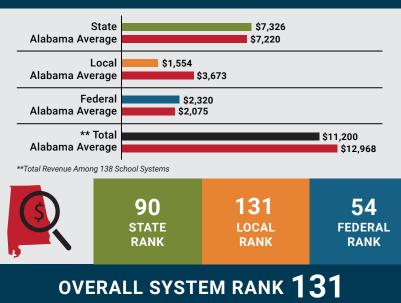

#### **Per-Pupil Revenue Sources**

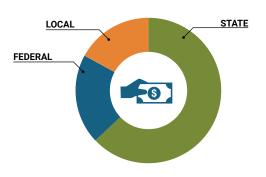
#### Chilton County Revenue Sources

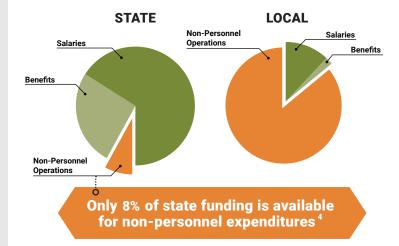
