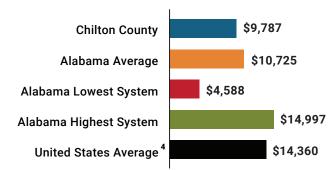

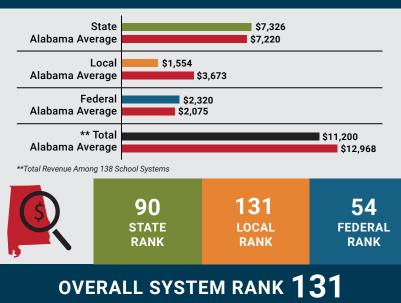

Per-Pupil Revenue Sources

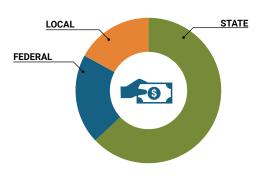
Chilton County Revenue Sources

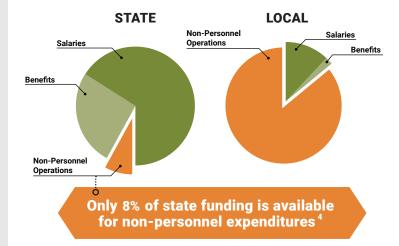
