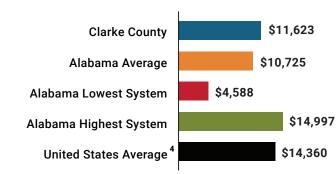

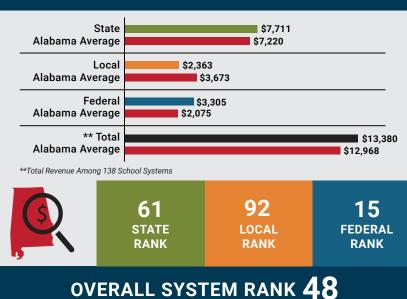

Per-Pupil Revenue Sources

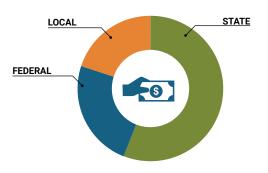
Clarke County Revenue Sources
