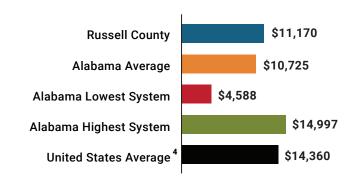

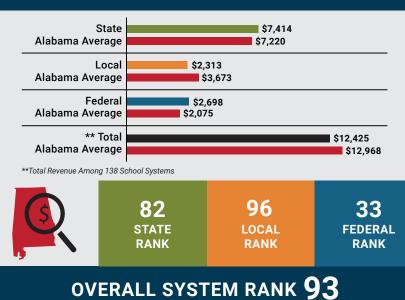

#### **Per-Pupil Revenue Sources**

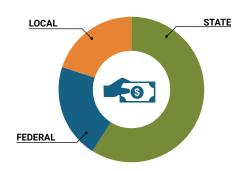
#### **Russell County Revenue Sources**

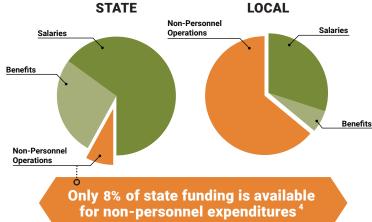
