






What is your top priority in the Foundation Program?




What is your top priority for new state education dollars?




What do you want to see funding in the supplemental budget, with one-time revenues?




If the legislature is going to change or prioritize additional funding for student groups, which of these would you prioritize? Percentage of members' top choice.




Looking at the potential financial impact of the CHOOSE Act, which statement best describes what you believe AASB should advocate for going forward:




What is your preferred solution to the issue of local boards of education currently not receiving a share of online sales tax (SSUT) revenue?




